Carlsberg's Super Bock hit with EUR400 million consumer antitrust claim in Portugal

In Brief

MLex Summary: Portugal's Super Bock has been hit with a 400 million-euro claim by a Portuguese consumer group seeking compensation because the Carlsberg-controlled brewer allegedly imposed minimum sale prices on bars and restaurants in the country going back to 2000. The opt-out lawsuit, filed in Portugal by Ius Omnibus, follows a 2019 decision by the national competition authority that found Super Bock broke competition law.
